



THIS JULY WE HAVE TWO VOYAGES, EACH FOR £695PP, AROUND THE SHORES OF SKYE FOR YOUR CONSIDERATION:

## WEST SKYE (7 NTS)

EMBARK: CASTLEBAY

AT 19.00 SAT 29TH JUNE 2019

DISEMBARK: MALLAIG

AT 19.00 SAT 6TH JULY 2019

OUR WEEK BEGINS IN CASTLEBAY, THE PORT OF BARRA, THE MOST SOUTHERLY ISLE OF THE OUTER HEBRIDES, WITH ITS ISOLATED BEACHES THAT HAVE BEEN POUNDED BY THE ATLANTIC, LEAVING MAJESTIC STRETCHES OF WHITE SANDS TO PLAY IN AND EXPLORE AS THE SUN DIPS OVER THE ATLANTIC.


WITH SAILS HOISTED, IT'S HALF A DAYS SAIL OVER TO THE NEIST POINT AND ALONG THE WEST SKYE COASTLINE TO EXPLORE ITS DEEP LOCHS AND DRAMATIC CLIFFS. AT THE NORTH END, IS DUNVEGAN LOCH WITH IT'S CASTLE, SEAT OF THE MACLEOD OF MACLEOD.

FUTHER ALONG, THE MACLEODS MAIDEN PINNACLES COME INTO VIEW, WHICH ARE BEST SEEN FROM THE WATER AND IT IS HERE THAT WE CAN ENTER LOCH HARPORT, FOR A CHANCE TO SAMPLE SKYE'S FAMOUS TALISKER WHISKEY.

ANCHORAGE IN LOCH NA CUILCE, ALLOWS US A SHORT HIKE TO THE STUNNING GLACIAL LOCH CORUISK, TO TAKE IN THE TRULY BREATH TAKING SCENERY OF THE CULLIN MOUNTAINS.

AT THIS POINT WE HOPE TO WEAVE SOUTH TO SPEND SOME DAYS EXPLORING THE SMALL ISLES OF CANNA, RUM AND EIGG, EACH POSSESSING IT'S OWN UNIQUE PERSONALITY AND GEOLOGY.

FOR THE LAST LEG, WE JOURNEY INTO THE FISHING PORT OF MALLAIG, WHERE OUR VOYAGE SADLY TERMINATES BUT NOT BEFORE PASSING THE WHITE SANDS OF MORAR, REMINDING US OF THE SANDS WHERE OUR VOYAGE BEGAN.



## EAST SKYE (7 NTS)

EMBARK: MALLAIG

AT 15.00 SAT 13TH JULY 2019

DISEMBARK: KYLE OF LOCHALSH

AT 15.00 SAT 20TH JULY 2019

OUR SECOND WEEK, WILL BE OF PARTICULAR INTEREST TO WILDLIFE ENTHUSIASTS AND FOR SCENERY, THE VOLCANIC EAST COAST OF SKYE, IS NO LESS SPECTACULAR.

CLOSE TO OUR START AT MALLAIG, IS THE REMOTE LOCH HOURN AND LOCH NEVIS, SEPARATED BY THREE MUNROS, WHICH MAKE A STUNNING STOP FOR OUR FIRST OVERNIGHT STAY. HERE IS THE OLD FORGE, A PUB THAT CAN BE REACHED ONLY BY SEA.

A LITTLE FURTHER UP THE NARROW CHANNEL BETWEEN THE MAINLAND AND SKYE WHERE MANY COLONIES OF SEALS PLAY IN THE FAST TIDES, IS LOCH DUICH, HOME OF EILEAN DONAN CASTLE, SCOTLAND'S MOST PHOTOGRAPHED MONUMENT.

TRAVELLING NORTH ALONG THE SKYE COAST, WE COME TO THE ISLE OF RAASAY, A HAVEN FOR WALKERS AND WILDLIFE SPOTTERS LOOKING TO CATCH A GLIMPSE OF GOLDEN EAGLES.

LOOK OUT FOR THE BASALT COLUMNS OF KILT ROCK, HERE, THERE ARE KITTIWAKES, FULMARS AND MEALT FALLS, A WATERFALL THAT PLUNGES 100M TO THE SHORELINE BELOW. CONTINUING ON TO THE NORTH, THE TROTTERNISH PENINSULA CAN BE REACHED, WITH IT'S UNUSUAL FORMATIONS OF QUIRAING AND OLD MAN OF STORR.

WITH SAILS HOISTED IT'S HALF A DAYS SAIL EAST, WITH THE TORRIDON MOUNTAINS IN VIEW AHEAD OF US AND TO THE REGION OF WESTER ROSS. FINALLY, WE TURN SOUTH TO THE SKYE BRIDGE, WHERE OUR VOYAGE ENDS AT KYLE OF LOCHALSH.
